In the 1960s, a salad made with jello became very popular in the United States. Jello salad was made of fruit, nuts, cheese, mayonnaise, vegetables, and sometimes even meat, all mixed together with jello and poured in a mold. It was common to see very strange combinations of foods brought together in one dish for this food fad! The dish that inspired this song's title is lime jello marshmallow cottage cheese surprise, which is a type of jello salad, but not the only dish composer William Bolcom writes about in the song!
