WHAT IS SNOW?

WHAT IS SNOW?

Snow is a type of precipitation; **precipitation** is liquid and solid water particles falling from clouds to the ground. **Rain** is the liquid form of precipitation. **Snow** forms when water particles high in the clouds freeze, turning into tiny crystals of ice. These ice crystals clump together to form **snowflakes**, which fall to the ground as snow when they get heavy enough.

Of course snow is cold because water only freezes below 32°F! Can you find all of the snowy words in the word puzzle below? (Hint: Make sure to check vertical, horizontal, and diagonal.)
