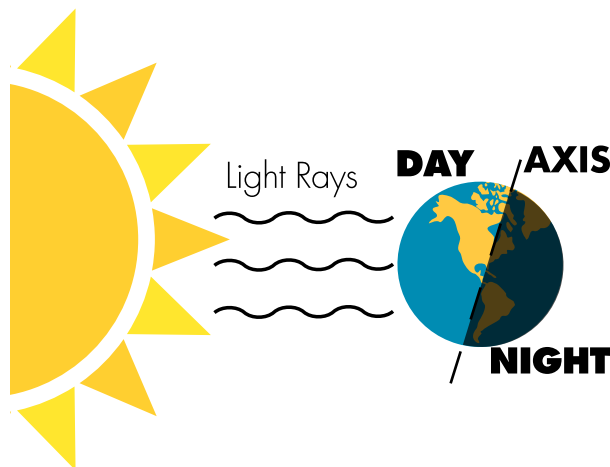

Why do we see the sun in the sky at some times and not at others? The sun rises in the morning and sets at night, which creates day and night. Let's learn more!

### THE EARTH ROTATES

The earth is a sphere, or a ball, which spins on its **axis**, or an imaginary line between the earth's two poles. This is called **rotation**, and each rotation takes 24 hours to complete. This is why the sun rises in the morning every day around the same time!

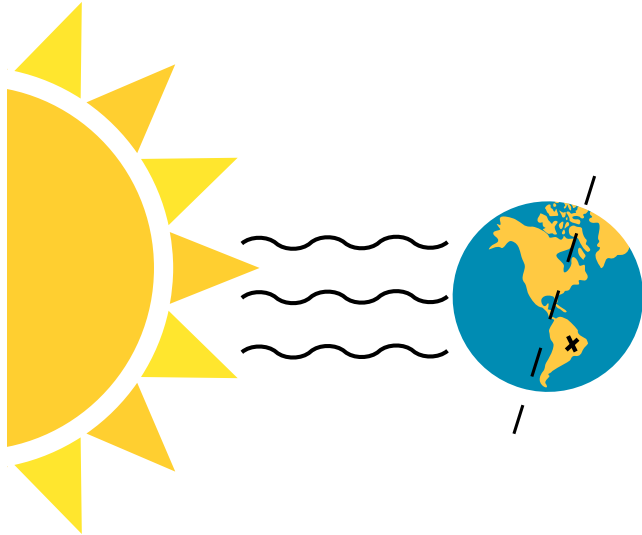
One side of the earth will always be facing the sun while the other side will be facing away from the sun. **Day** is when you can see the sun from where you are, and the sun's light and heat can reach you. **Night** is when the sun is on the other side of the Earth from where you are, and the sun's light and heat can't reach you.





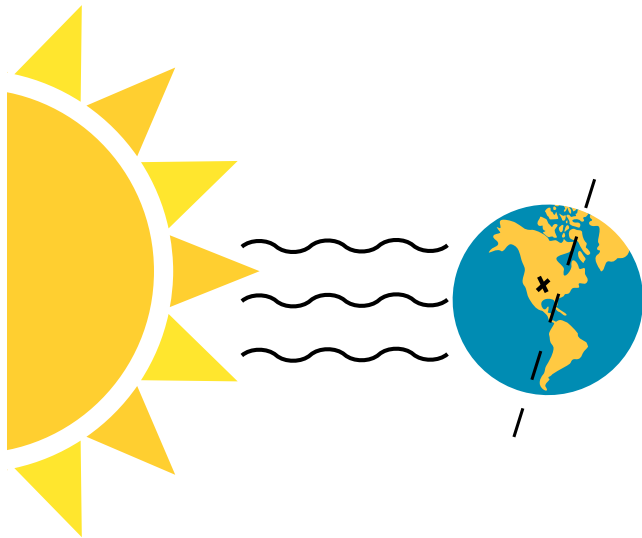

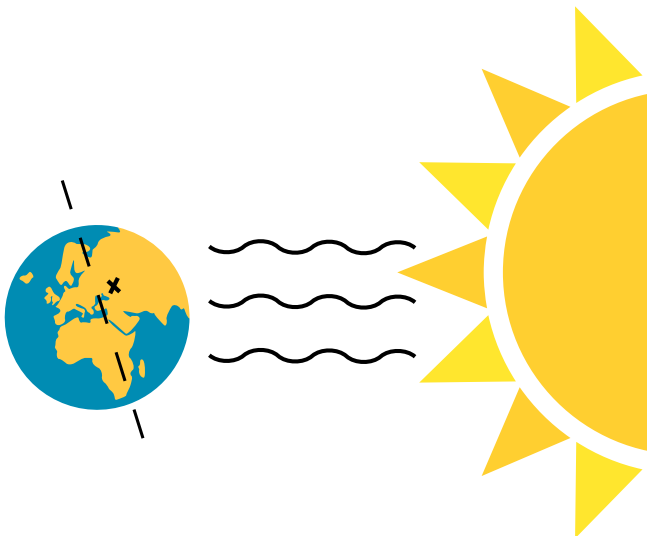
