WHAT IS SNOW?

Precipitation is water falling from clouds to the ground. Precipitation can come as liquid water (rain or drizzle) or frozen, solid water (snow or hail). Snow forms when the temperature is at or below freezing, and there is not a lot of moisture in the air. Of course snow is cold, because water only freezes below 32°F! Can you find all of the snowy words in the word puzzle below? (Hint: Make sure to check vertical, horizontal, and diagonal.)
