## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

### ARTIST PRACTICE ROOMS & LOUNGE

Work with Cliburn staff and volunteer chairman to provide all needs pertaining to the artist practice rooms (scheduling and monitoring) and artist lounge. Serve as welcome committee, provide check-in for artists, distribute information packets and welcome bags, provide information regarding Competition and the Fort Worth area. Provide hospitality for artists and their family members, replenish snack items, and keep area clean. Comfortable communicating with individuals whose English may be limited. Assist with lounge load-in and load-out. Should have organizational, team, and time management skills, as well as community relations skills. Orientation & arrangements coordination fall 2022. Concentration during Competition.

### GIFT SHOP

Work Cliburn Gift Shop shifts during the Amateur Competition under the direction of the Cliburn Director of Marketing and Gift Shop Chairmen. Duties include preparing merchandise for sale, working the sales floor, promoting Cliburn merchandise, making sales, restocking shelves, providing customer service, and other related activities. Additional duties include gift shop set-up, load-in, and load-out. Focus on organizational, retail, and team skills. Orientation September 2022. Concentration during Competition. Shifts begin one hour prior to performances and end 30 minutes after performances. Shifts are approximately 4–5 hours in length (Shift length TBD).

### PAGE TURNERS

Page turners will meet competitors for short rehearsals and turn pages during performances at Van Cliburn Recital Hall in the Maddox-Muse Center and in Bass Hall. Dates are October 12-18, 2022. Specific instructions regarding dress and scheduling will follow.

### REPERTOIRE and MUSIC LIBRARY

Assist Cliburn staff in proofing repertoire lists. Work with Cliburn staff to prepare scores for chamber music and four-hand readings. Download scores and organize music library for use by the jury.

### STUDENT VOLUNTEERS

Assist Cliburn staff and area chairmen in preparing for and executing the Amateur Competition with volunteer concentration during Competition and two days prior. Assist with load-in to and load-out from Competition locations—Maddox Muse Center and Bass Hall. Assist in all areas of the Competition from event set-up, artist practice rooms and lounge, gift shop, errands, etc.

### TRANSPORTATION

Provide transportation for jurors and Cliburn guests to and from DFW airport and hotel or Bass Hall prior to, during, and after the Amateur Competition. Usually scheduled in advance, however, sometimes flight reservations are changed requiring short notice for needed transport. Needs to be comfortable communicating with individuals whose English may be limited. Flexible, adapt easily to a changing environment with a positive attitude. Schedule with Cliburn staff and transportation chairman. Concentration October 11-19, 2022.

### WELCOME BAGS

Work with Cliburn staff and volunteer chairmen to obtain local area information brochures, snacks, treats, “goodies,” and other Fort Worth items for artists, jurors, and press welcome bags. Assist in assembling and transporting bags to Maddox-Muse Center and Bank of America 6<sup>th</sup> floor suite prior to Competition.
