# CLIBURN IN THE CLASSROOM PET PARADE Our favorite animals set to music

CLASS ACTIVITY: Talk to the Animals Grade Level(s): 1-5 Subject Areas: Music, Creative Writing

### OBJECTIVE

Students will learn the song Talk to the Animals and write a creative writing page based on the prompt below. If desired, teachers may submit a student's story to the Cliburn to be featured on the Cliburn Kids website.

#### SPACE AND EQUIPMENT CONSIDERATIONS

Pencil and paper are the only materials needed for this activity. Colored pencils may also be used to draw a picture of their pet.

## ACTIVITY

- 1. Learn the original version of the song listed above using form (verse, chorus, etc). This may be repeated over the course of several class periods as a "warm-up."
- 2. Explore the various styles that the song has been reworked into. Incorporate dance for a movement element; for example, dance the samba version along with Debbie Curtis Big Band Aid.
- 3. Allow students the time to write a page about an imaginary conversation with their pet or favorite animal. Write the reflection questions below on the whiteboard to act as a prompt for their story. Teachers may select a student's work to submit to the Cliburn to be featured on our education website.

#### REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- 1. What "languages" are named in the song? Which of those languages would you like to learn?
- 2. If my pet/favorite animal could talk, what would they say to me?
- 3. If my pet could understand me, what would I want them to know?
- 4. Would my pet be good with names? Would they remember my name and the names of our family? Would they know their own names?
- 5. What places would my pet ask to visit?
