
Now, listen again; Buddy shows you the important tune to listen for in music. He plays it all over the piano, so it might sound a little different each time! Listen carefully, and count how many times you hear the tune repeat while he plays the music.

How many times did you hear it?

When something is repeated again and again, it creates a **pattern**. How this music repeats the same tune in different parts of the piano is a kind of pattern. The pattern of a piece of music is called form. The form tells us how a piece of music is put together! The form of this music is a **fugue**, in which the main tune is played many times in different parts of the keyboard.
