Now, watch carefully while Lewis plays – Do his hands ever leave the piano keyboard? If they do, what do you hear when his hands are off the piano?

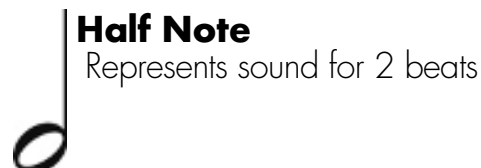
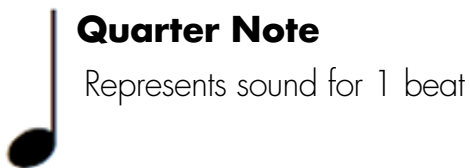
