HALF STEPS



Buddy shows us how the composer Alexander Scriabin makes the piano sound like a mosquito! Have you ever been bitten by a mosquito before? What happens when a mosquito bites you?

What kind of sound do mosquitos make?

To imitate the buzzing sound, Scriabin takes two notes and plays them very fast. This is called a **trill**. Then, Buddy explores which two notes create the mosquito buzzing sound with a trill – how far apart are the two notes he decides on?

When two notes are right next to each other, it is called a half step.



Can you identify the half steps? Circle all the half-step pairs you see below.
