MUSICAL TEAMS

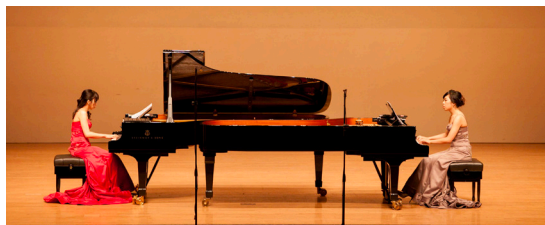


In this episode, Buddy's friend Evan Mitchell joins us as a special guest! The two pianists played together as an **ensemble**, a kind of musical team. An ensemble is a group of two or more people singing or playing music together. One person playing music alone is called a **soloist**, and the piece they play is called a **solo**. When two people make music together, the ensemble is called a **duo**. Three musicians playing together is called a **trio**. Fun fact: when two pianists play together as a duo, it can also be called piano four hands!

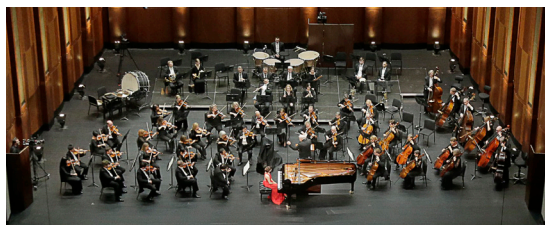

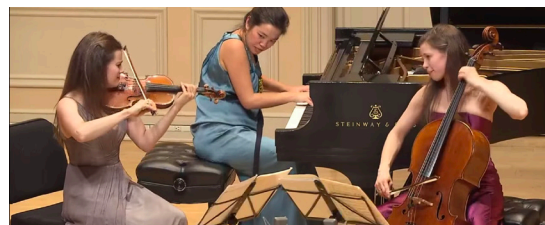
