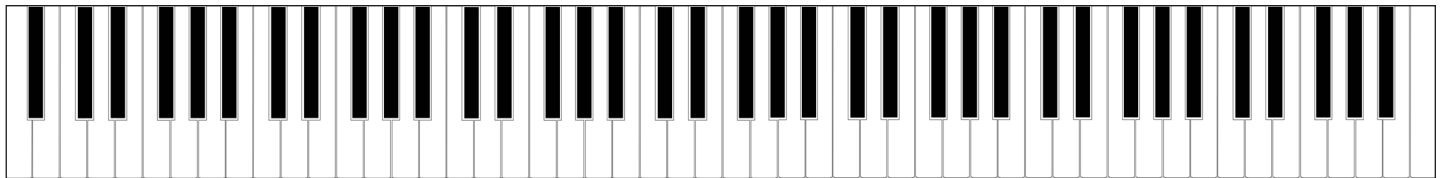
Just like you can paint pictures with a brush and paint, music can paint pictures with sound, too! Today's music is about baby chicks dancing in their shells.
